


10 Reasons to Live in **BELIZE**

The cost of living

The cost of living is low... **half what you'd spend** in the rest of the Caribbean or the U.S. A couple can live well for **\$2,000 a month**, including rent, in Corozal, Belize.

Real estate prices are still low for a Caribbean destination. In Bermuda the average condo price would be \$830,000. In Belize you can still own a luxury condo on **Ambergris Caye**—the country's most popular resort island—for **\$200,000**.

Take advantage of the **Qualified Retired Persons Program**.


Benefits of this program include:
